

- 3. Approval of Minutes from 11-14-18, 2-13-2019, 3-13-19, 6-3-2019, and 08-14-2019




INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY (IT) EVACUATION MAP Report to Staging Area (SA) 1




THEATER (THTR) EVACUATION MAP




STUDENT SERVICES (SSV) EVACUATION MAP






WILFRED J. AIRELY LIBRARY (LIBR) DOWNSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP Report to Staging Area (SA) 1


WILFRED J. AIRELY LIBRARY (LIBR) UPSTAIRS EVACUATION MAP Report to Staging Area (SA) 1


APPLIED TECHNOLOGY (AT) EVACUATION MAP Report to Staging Area (SA) 1




APPLIED TECHNOLOGY (AT) EVACUATION MAP Report to Staging Area (SA) 2



STEM CENTER EVACUATION MAP




STEM CENTER MODULARS EVACUATION MAP



WEST END QUAD EVACUATION MAP


