3.1 Survey of Effectiveness

- The survey will stay open to encourage more participation.

3.2 Hotep Equity Audit

- Two themes have potentially been identified: one for fall and one for spring. These themes are designed for students that are not part of any special programs.
 - Fall Welcome Week 2.0; have a deliberate approach towards students. The week should include options for career exploration and spotlighting the various programs on campus.
 - Spring Community College Week: all students fall into this realm; can include some of the work that is being done at the state level.
- Discussion about having a master calendar for students.

- Is it possible to have a screen in the Corral that shows what's happening on campus.
- Find ways to share this information with students as much as possible
- The ASNC app may have this function and could be the possible solution.

3.3 KPI 12: Reducing the Equity Gap for Foster Youth by 40%

- Dean McCarson shared the definition of foster youth, and the two support programs at Norco College charged with providing support to our foster youth population.
 - Next Up
 - Phoenix Scholars
- Various metrics were shared including the gap for students who are planning for transfer.
 - There is a trend, this population can take longer than most to reach transfer completion. Two possible reasons identified were students taking fewer units and having drop rates. However, certificates are completed and jobs are obtained after certificate completion.
 - There is work happening to close all gaps; however, there is an emphasis to monitor the gap in transfer, and in English and Math.
 - It is important to note that most students in this community take classes in person as online serves as a barrier.
- Action plan
 - ENG 885 should be promoted for concurrent enrollment with English 1A/B courses. Offer dedicated tutoring support.
 - Basic needs and mental health services are needed to remove barriers and are a consistent factor for students.
 - Promote transfer planning via college tours, counseling meetings, and university representatives.
 - Above all, our Foster Youth community is resilient.
