3.1 Norco Advantage and Promise Program Workgroup Update

Promise Program

- Move away from a one-day format back to multiple days-used to do a week, 4 days that included English and Math track, counseling and a Fair.
 - Include Online option-beyond academics.
 - High school seniors are not thinking about applying (still thinking about Senior events, graduation).
 - Submitting their applications in Fall, informed in Spring if accepted to 4-year university.
 - Making an intelligent choice beyond academics
 - Coming to Norco College-taking the same English 1A class that is also offered at a 4-year university.
 - Dual Enrollment student currently not the premier focus.
 - Students are influenced by their family and friends
 - Served 400+ students & increased unit load & rentetion.
 - Focus on non-traditional students
 - Bring students to campus-Open House
- Early Commitment Program-new name for Norco College Promise Program
 - First time college student
 - Through FAFSA and Dreamers app.
 - CCPG was based off of BOG Waiver Promise was specifically for enrollment fee.
 - Receive the CCPG or Promise (have to be a fulltime student)
 - Both must apply for FAFSA
 - Promise Program not need based.
 - Eliminate application and prior agreement (agreement is given after admission)
 - Will have an approval process and dropped if falls below fulltime status. Dropped from program with no appeal process.
 - Current program has no deadline in place.
 - Student must be a Norco College student for NC Promise Program.

Norco Advantage

- Previously, Summer Advantage, shifted based on AB705 which created logistical issues and was later dismantled.
 - Bring back services and academic approach
 - Had an orientation-lots of information given and expected to retain.
 - Ask students "What do you want?"
 - Building a community
 - Pandemic happened and now have hybrid option

- More of a Guided Pathways approach, through onboarding
- Looking forward not always best answer-look at history
