1. Call to Order 12:50 p.m.
2. Consent Calendar- Ruth Leal
 - a. Motion (Kamerin/Finley): Approve minutes from May 21, 2015.

3. **Committee Business: Damon Nance**
 - a. Member Role & Responsibilities

Mr. Nance reminded the committee that we have a formal member role and responsibility document which is posted on our committee webpage, and which details the expectations for all Technology Committee members. He emphasized the necessity of being prompt and staying for the entire meeting since our meetings are only scheduled for one hour per month. He reviewed the option to designate a proxy if a member will be absent for an extended period of time. Any and all guests are welcome to attend, but we have a decided composition of 7 faculty members, 7 staff, 2 students, and 2 administrators which must be approved by committee vote.

4. **Technology Plan- Ruth Leal**

a. Subcommittees Report

Ms. Leal provided an update regarding the subcommittees.

Goal #1 subcommittee reported that workshops were held in the summer aimed at staff but included faculty called “Learn with Lynda” and had 34 attendees on subjects such as Word 2013, Communication, and Organizing Your Office. These topics were based on the 2014 and 2015 Technology Survey results. A nor-all was sent out to the college to announce that Lynda.com has been renewed for 2015/2016. Once the student accounts are uploaded, there will be a banner ad on the website, social media posts, a student email, and posters & digital signage throughout campus. The subcommittee also announced a new email address for Lynda.com which is lynda@norcolleage.edu.

Goal #3 subcommittee provided a status update in the 2014 Program Review Technology Requests for reassignment of equipment that it has been completed. 2015 Program Review Technology Requests will be coming soon for the Technology Committee to review and make recommendations to BFPC.

Goal #4 & 5 subcommittees will meet again to discuss objectives in these goals and report at that time.

Goal #6 subcommittee has presented to BFPC and ISPC councils the recommendation of Computer Equipment Refresh 2015 which outlines 25 percent of the oldest computer equipment at Norco to be replaced as identified on the annual inventory. This recommendation is in accordance with the *Norco College Replacement of Technology Infrastructure and Equipment Plan*. This recommendation will be placed in the program review for Technology Support Services.

The Computer Equipment Inventory list, Tech Request Form for purchases & report, and the Technology Total Cost of Ownership document were provided to Technology Support Services for updates and implementation. The Computer Equipment Inventory list will be updated and provided to the Technology Committee at the beginning of each fall and spring semester. The Tech Request Form will be implemented for all purchases of equipment/software. The Technology Total Cost of Ownership will be updated to include estimates for the end user to include in program review/budgeting. In addition, all of the forms have been uploaded to the Technology Committee’s Document webpage.

b. Technology Survey 2015

Goal # 7 subcommittee shared the results of the Technology Survey 2015 for faculty, staff, and students. It was completed by 50 faculty, 48 staff, and 204 students. Discussion proceeded among committee members about the survey responses and the plan to turn them in to objectives for this academic year.

The faculty survey had positive results overall but was noted by committee members that the high percentage of dissatisfaction should not be overlooked. The survey reflected that 31% of faculty are dissatisfied with the performance of college computer (classroom/office) and noted issues such as upgrades needed, mac support, slow computers, outdated software, software updates, and maintenance. 31% of faculty felt classrooms are not equipped with adequate technology and 33% felt that general use classrooms need more technology. The committee discussed tech standards. 31% of faculty state the need for a troubleshooting help desk and noted the need for mac support.

The following were some notable results from the student survey: 39% bring their own computer to school and 38% use computer in the library but noted that they are slow and there are not enough computers, 35% students used Lynda.com, 72% use an external drive/cloud drive to store documents, 32% dissatisfied with the college Wi-Fi, 47% students wish instructor used email more and students mentioned using apps like ClassStatus to inform students of when class is cancelled or other info. (See attached survey results).

5. **Strategic Plan Assessment Findings #10, 11 & 14 – Damon Nance**

- a. Mr. Nance reminded the committee that it was decided in the spring to look at three assessment findings again in the fall. He asked the committee if they would still like to have further discussion on Strategic Plan Assessment Findings #10, 11 and 14 which are listed on page 11 of the Technology Plan. Planning assumption assessment finding #10 states that “not all academic programs have computers dedicated for their use”. The committee agrees to have further discussion regarding the general use classroom technology consistency and standards regarding finding #10. The next one is planning assumption #11 which says that “students have very limited access to printing on campus. The committee decided to further discuss this item as well. The next item is assessment finding #14 which states that “there is no technology help desk for students”. The committee members agree to further discuss this item. These items will be placed on future agendas for detailed discussion.

6. **Streaming Equipment Replacement Project - Dan Lambros**

Q1 Are you full-time or part-time?

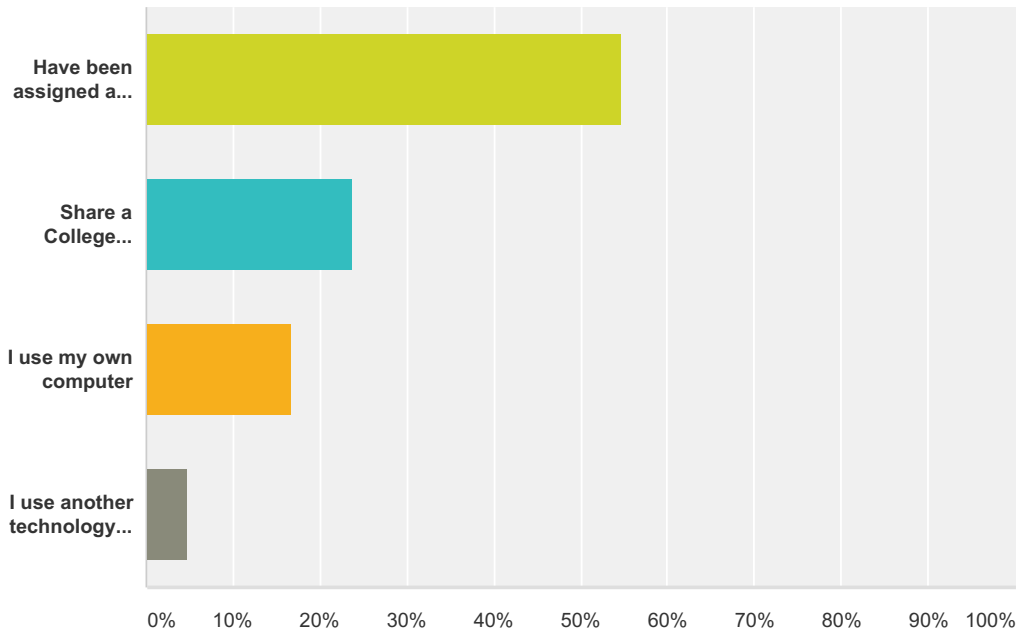

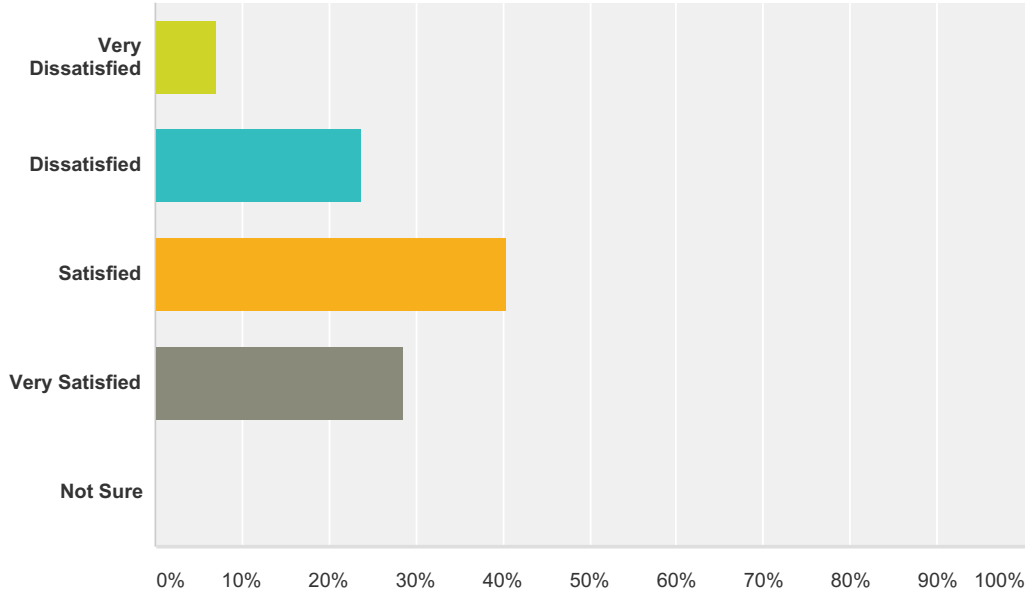

Q5 How do you store your course documents? (Check all that apply)

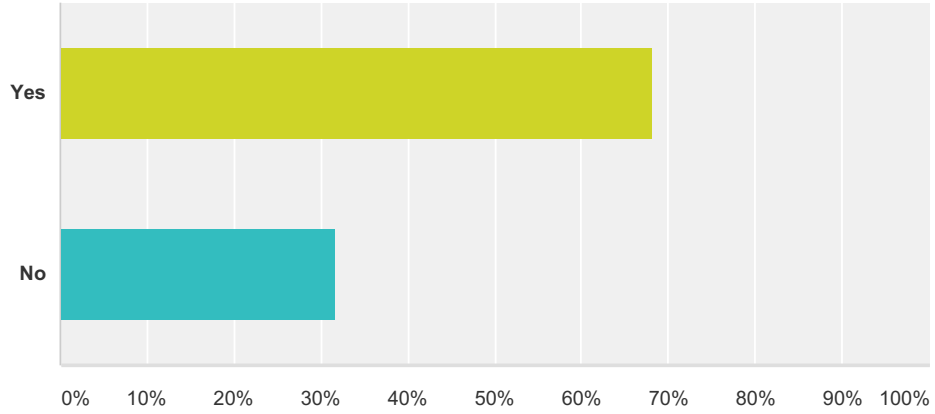

Q6 Is your classroom equipped with adequate technology to fit your teaching needs?

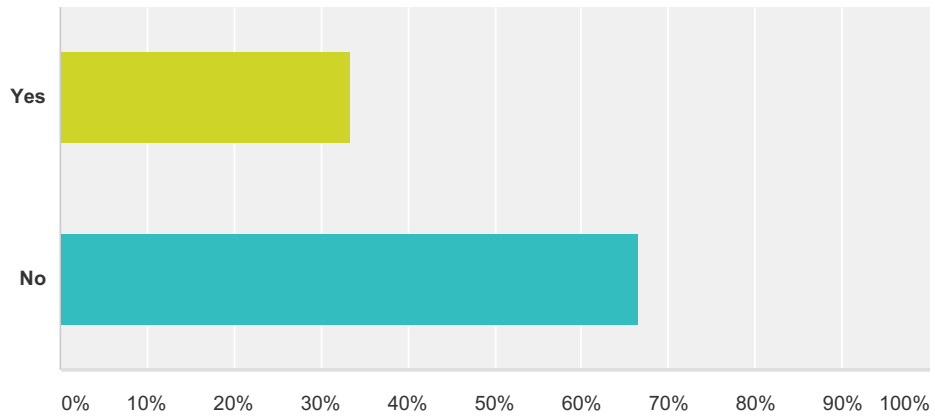

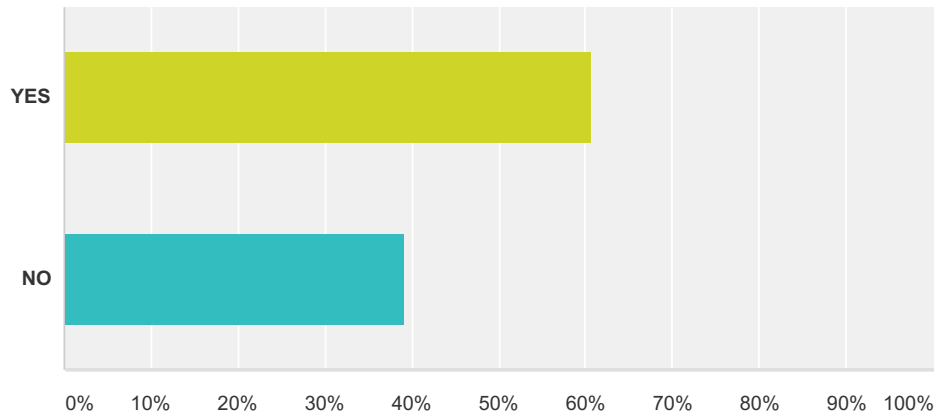

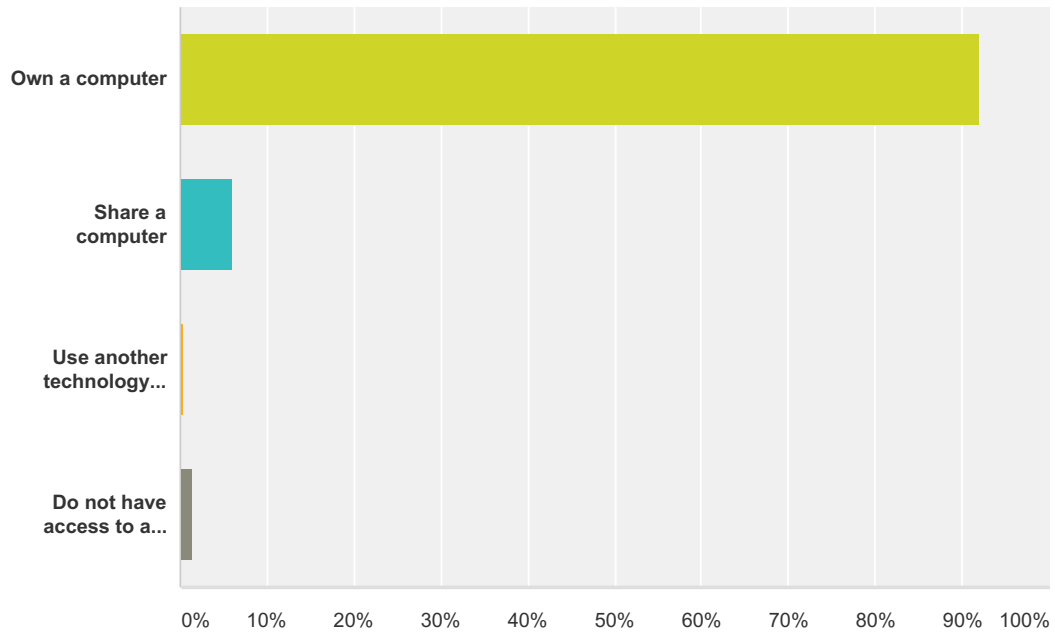

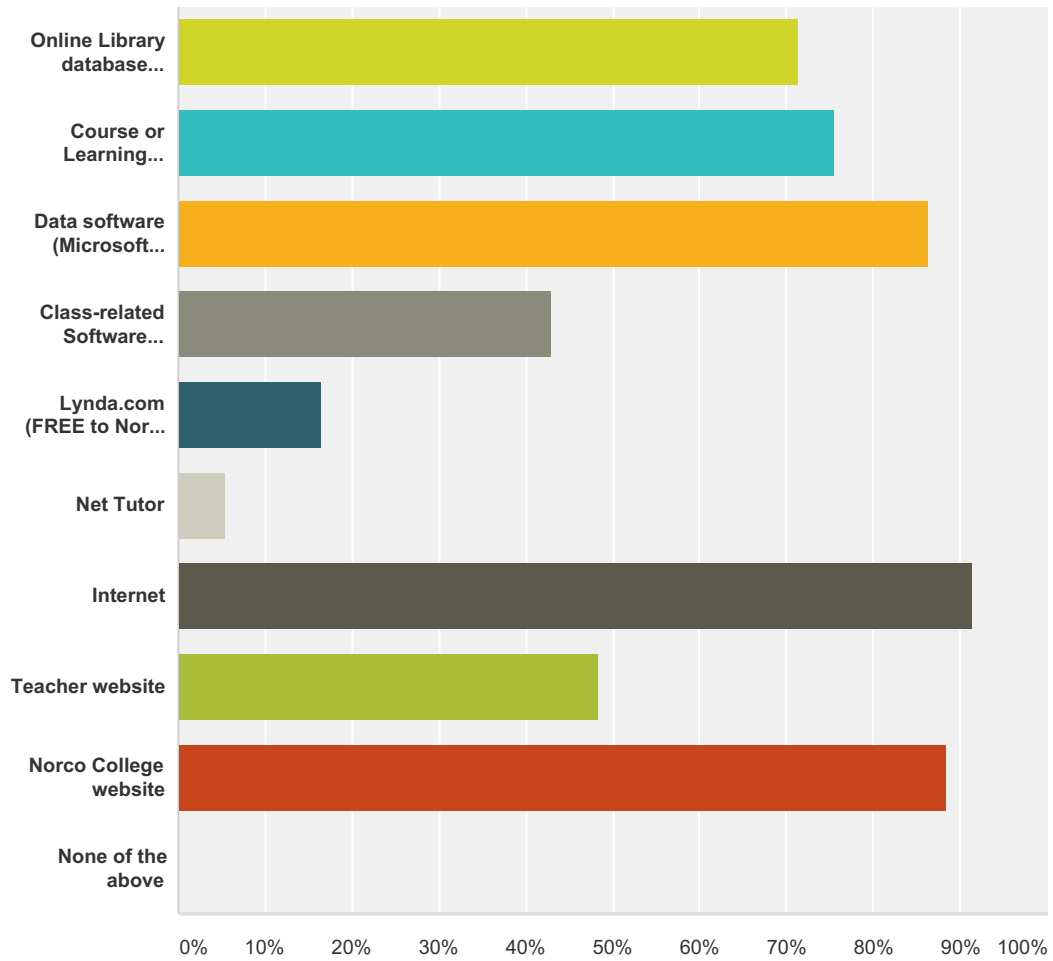

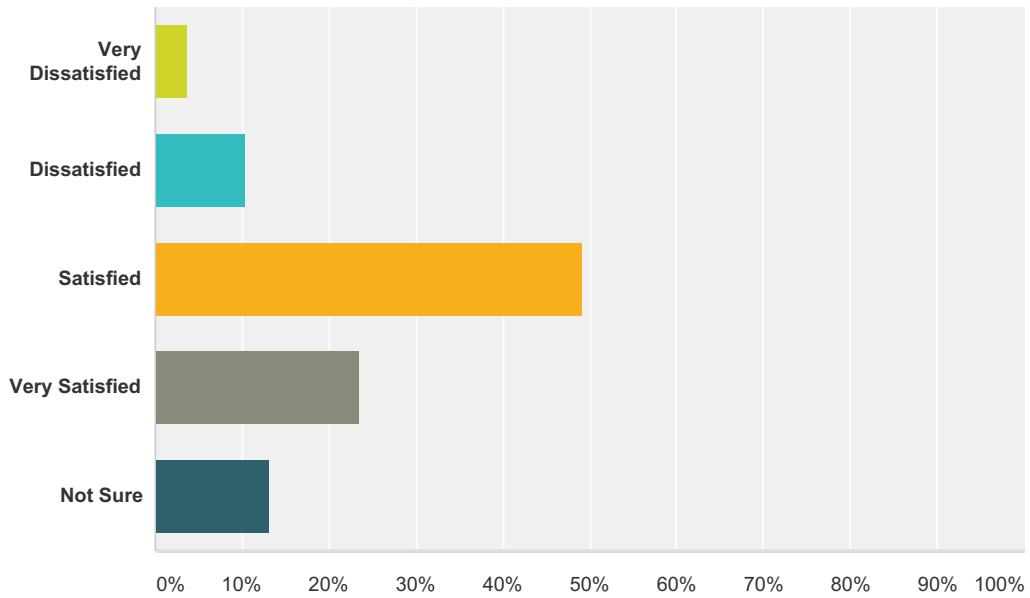

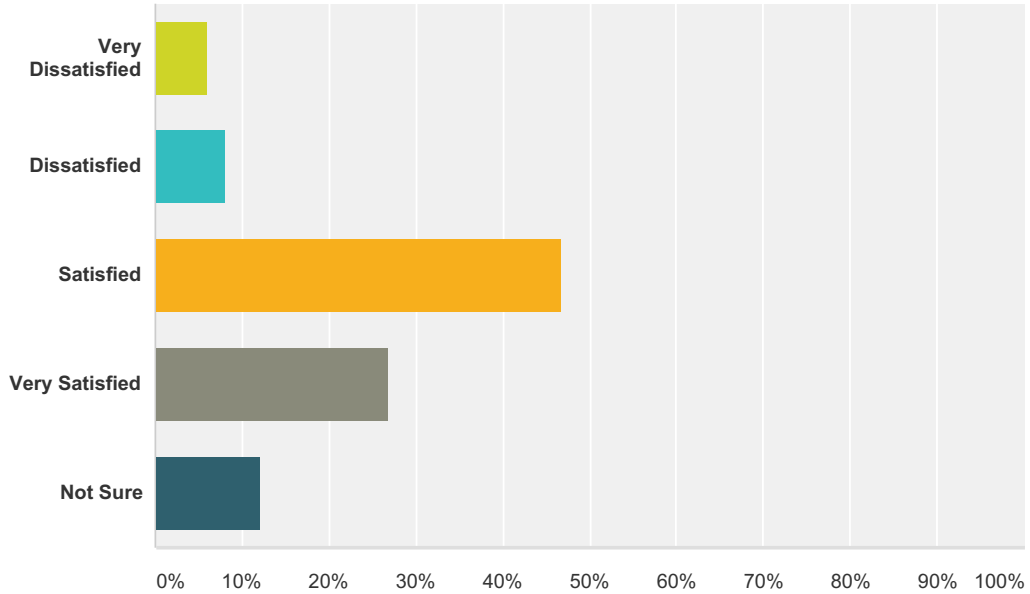

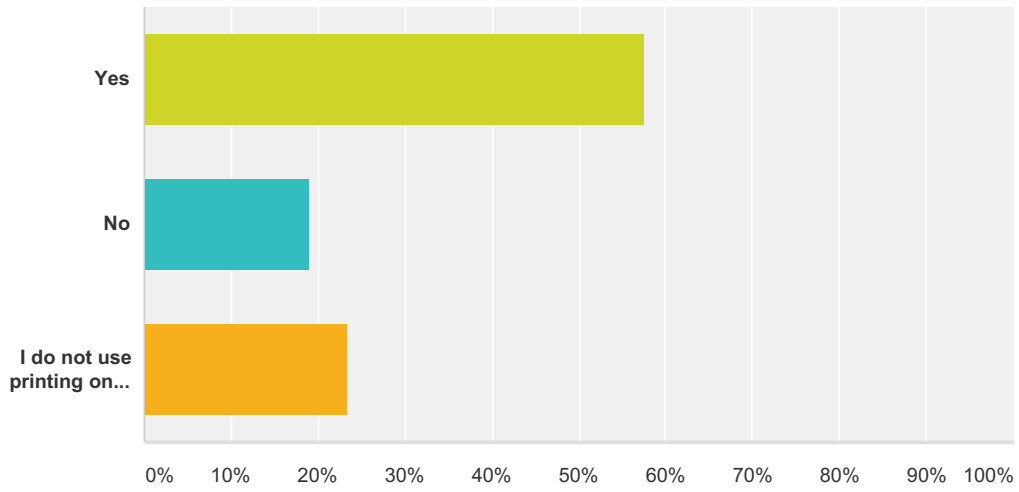

Q12 In your opinion, are there sufficient printing options available on campus?

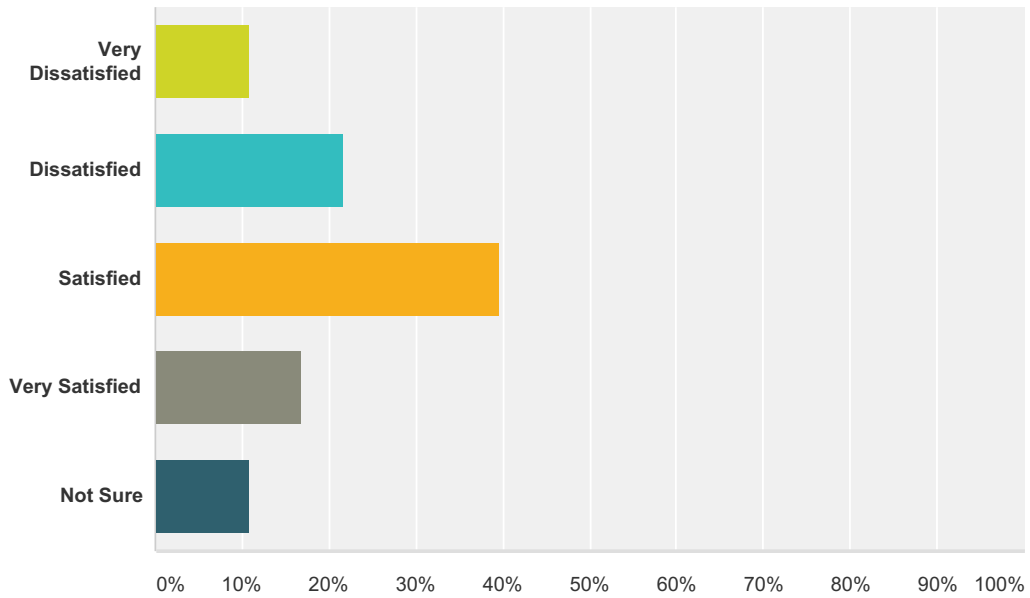
