## 2. Technology Plan – Ruth Leal and David Schlanger

- a. 2019-2025 Technology Plan and Goals Report
  - i. Technology Survey Comparison – Lenny provided a comparison of the 2019, 2020, and 2021 surveys and highlighted areas that reflect changes in feedback, show trends, and areas of improvement/decline. The committee discussed the comparison document.
  - ii. Charter Status Update – David provided an update that the charter was approved by the Resources Council and revisions were made. David reviewed the revisions. The co-chairs requested a document reflecting the track changes and the Resources Council provided it. Discussion on changes. The committee recommended the co-chairs open a dialogue with the Resources Council co-chairs on the revisions and suggest bringing the charter back in the spring with suggested revisions in order to resubmit to the Resources Council.
  - iii. Technology Trainings for Spring – Lenny. Using the Technology Survey as the basis for technology training, Lenny led a discussion from the committee on the technology trainings that could potentially be offered in the spring to faculty, classified professionals, and students. Excel would be the next workshop on Office 365 Microsoft Workshop. Suggested a workshop on accessible flyers for Canvas for faculty. Lenny will make videos available on the help/training page.
