- I. Motion to Approve Agenda
  - a. Move: Graham – Second: Burnett
  - b. Approved unanimously.
- II. Motion to Approve Minutes
  - a. Move: Graham – Second: Burnett
  - b. Approved unanimously. Three abstentions.
- III. Introductions
  - a. Committee members introduced themselves. Visitors were warmly welcomed.
- IV. Discussion on role of TLC in the College
  - a. Justice presented an overview of the role of TLC at the college.
  - b. Justice discussed Guided Pathways.
    - i. Justice positioned TLC as potentially tied to the 4<sup>th</sup> pillar of Guided Pathways: ensuring learning.
    - ii. Justice also indicated that equity runs through all of this work.
  - c. Justice put forth the co-chairs' proposal that TLC take a leadership role in coordinating more extended training opportunities.
    - i. Justice cited Chaffey College's training programs as a potential model to follow.
  - d. Graham pointed out that we need to find our own place where we can carve out our own role without stepping on other committees.
  - e. Burnett pointed out that we should potentially consider separate tracks for in-person and online pedagogy.
  - f. Potential suggestions for symposiums.
    - i. Online teaching
    - ii. Assessment and discussion of results.
  - g. J. Tyler suggested that TLC potentially serve as a conduit for faculty to provide access to information learned at conferences and other work outside college.
    - i. Along with that conduit would involve an archival element of these ideas.

- ii. Perhaps that archival element would include video archives of various sessions and some sort of quiz system to check on learning.
  - h. Discussion ensued over overlap between TLC and other committees.
  - i. Adams mentioned a shared video communication system that connects educators nationally and internationally—the responsible organization is Zero to Three, which hosts an online learning community Member Connect
  - j. Reade stated he would develop a statement of purpose based upon the committee's input for consideration at the next meeting.
