Brady Kerr is a Grammy nominated educator, a voting member of The Recording Academy, an Avid Certified Instructor in Pro Tools, and full-time Music Industry Studies faculty at Norco College. Kerr can be found producing and engineering in the Norco College recording studio, as well as teaching Digital Audio Production, Pro Tools, Songwriting, and Performance Techniques for Studio Recording courses.

The Music Industry Studies program has released six studio albums under the moniker Norco Music, and will be releasing its seventh album,

Boundless, on November 17 of this year. All of Norco Music's albums have been produced in state-of-the-art facilities on the Norco College campus. Kerr has recording and producing credits for the six previous Norco Music releases: Collision Course (2017), Compass Heart (2016), Out of the Darkness | Into the Light (2015), Alive (2014), Falling Awake (2013), and Take Me There (2012); all of which are available on iTunes, Spotify, Amazon and anywhere else you stream music.

Kerr has been involved with music and theater for over 30 years, 18 of which have taken place at Norco College. He is a classically trained pianist and vocalist, and an award-winning composer. Kerr spends most of his creative time as a recording engineer, music producer, vocal coach, and graphic designer—he recently launched his own freelance graphic design business, Meraki Design (www.merakidesign.space), fulfilling a longtime dream of having an online portfolio of his creative works.
