Some of Tyler's more noteworthy performances include gigs with Grammy Award-winning jazz piano player Bill Cunliffe, legendary blues guitarist Kid Ramos, and iconic rockabilly guitarist Paul Pigat. Tyler has studied with world-class drummers such as Peter Erskine, Bernie Dresel, Kenny Aronoff, and Chad Wackerman.
