Week 3– July 25th-July 28th

Students will work in teams, use the Engineering Design Process and LEGO® EV3 Mindstorms robots to solve challenges that face mechanical and robotics engineers.

Norco College, in collaboration with Engineering for Kids, will supply the curriculum, instructors and materials. Students will not keep the materials used in the camp. Students need to bring a desire to learn and a sack lunch.
