About: 2016 is the 25th Anniversary of the Norco College campus. Norco College began a campaign to raise money for student scholarships last year and is continuing this effort now. The campaign is called the Silver Scholarship because it is our silver anniversary here in Norco. The Silent Auction is an opportunity for Norco College students to create original art and sell it during a Silent Auction on May 3, 2016. 50% of the sale will go directly to the student artist. The other 50% will go to the Silver Scholarship Fund. All works will have a starting bid of \$100, with \$20 bidding increments. Bidders may also choose the "Guaranteed Purchase" option for \$250.

Requirements: Student artists must be Norco College students currently enrolled at Norco College this semester. Students do not need to be art majors or be enrolled in an art class. Artwork must be 100% original work. All media will be accepted: drawing, painting, watercolor, collage, digital art, photography and sculpture. Artwork should be in good condition, ready to display. 2D works do not need to be matted or framed, however, professional presentation is advised. The maximum size accepted will be 22 in. x 30 in. for 2D works, 24 in. in any direction for 3D work. **The artwork must celebrate, illustrate or be inspired by NORCO COLLEGE.**

Deadline: All work must be delivered to the Art Gallery (ST-111) on or before **Tues. April 26, 2016**. Students may submit 1-3 works.
