While you may not have been accustomed to teaching online entirely, we have many tools ready to use and more are on the way! Tools are here for you to use. Take one or two each week to phase them into your instruction and to avoid overwhelming yourself and your students.

Please be advised in this time of preparation and transition there is <u>no obligation</u> to implement third-party apps *in addition* to the following recommended Canvas features.

Announcements

- To maintain Regular and Substantive Contact (ACCJC)
- To communicate with the entire class
- Enable announcements on the Home page of your class to alert all students logging in for the first time
- Include or exclude replies to have an active conversation or a public broadcast to the class
- > <u>Discussions</u> to keep students in communication with you and with each other
 - See the RCCD Recommended Template distributed this week
 - RCCD DE has already created <u>Prompts</u> to edit and enjoy
- ► <u>Inbox</u>
 - o To directly communicate with individual, few, several or all students
- ► <u>Files</u>
 - To house your many documents and resources for students
 - I recommend hiding this from student view unless you want them to see everything at once
 - Use it as a storehouse and use Modules to sequence their access
- Modules
 - Pace your instruction in blocks as you would in a usual weekly, unit or monthly cycle
 - o Publish only a few items at a time together or in sequence
 - Keeps students working together at a similar pace

- <u>Track progress for all students</u> to avoid repetition of Announcements and to isolate those needing additional support
- Quizzes and/or <u>Assignments</u>
 - Already integrated into your course, accessible and free to students
 - Maintains continuity of instruction when used with Discussion Boards on a weekly basis
- Speed Grader
 - Comment directly to each student
 - Use Rubrics to align Assignments with SLOs
 - Simplify your Assessment processes this Spring
