### Norco College 2019-21 Equity Plan Data 80% Rule Methodology

#### **GOAL:**

This spreadsheet provides the data that was used to help develop the Norco College 2019-22 Equity Plan. Each tab contains data for the specific metric. Within each tab, tables and figures are provided to show the disproportionate impact study for the Norco College population disaggregated by gender and Ethnicity, Disability, First Generation, Foster Youth, LGBTQ+, Low Income, and Veterans (some factors are not available for certain metrics). The 80% Rule methodology was used to determine disproportionately impacted groups.

#### **METRICS:**

A rate that calculates students who applied in either the 2016-17 or 2017-18

academic years and enrolled during the 2017-18.

Fall-Spring Retention: A rate that calculates students who were enrolled in Fall 2017 and also enrolled

in Spring 2018.

MAT ENG Completion: A rate that calculates students who successfully complete transfer-level Math

and English in their first year during 2017-18.

Degree Rate: A rate that calculates students who started in Fall 2014 and received an

Associate degree by Spring 2018.

Certificate Rate: A rate that calculates students who started in Fall 2014 and received a

Chancellor's Office approved certificate by Spring 2018.

Transfer Rate: A rate that calculates students who started in Fall 2014 and transferred to a

four-year institution by Spring 2018.
