












13. In the past 12 months, how many times have you moved?


14. In the past 12 months, have you stayed in an unhealthy relationship to have somewhere to live?


15. In the past 12 months, did you leave your household because you felt unsafe?


16. How safe do you feel where you currently live?


17. In the past 12 months, have you ever been homeless?




20. Is your home in a public housing project, owned by a local housing authority or other public agency?


21. Do you receive a public housing voucher, such as Section 8, to subsidize the cost of private housing?


22. Do you have any biological, adopted, step, or foster children who live in your household?
















30. In the last 30 days, were you ever hungry but didn't eat because there wasn't enough money for food?


31. In the last 30 days, did you lose weight because there wasn't enough money for food?


32. In the last 30 days, did you stay in an unhealthy relationship so you or you and your family would have enough food?




40. What type of meal plan do you have?











59. In the last year, did a parent or guardian claim you as a “dependent” for tax purposes?






