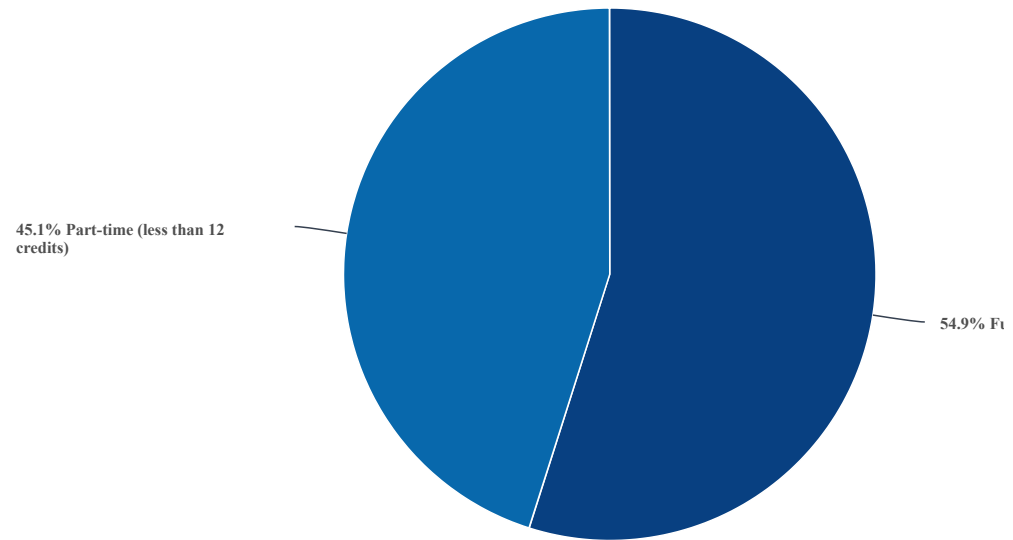

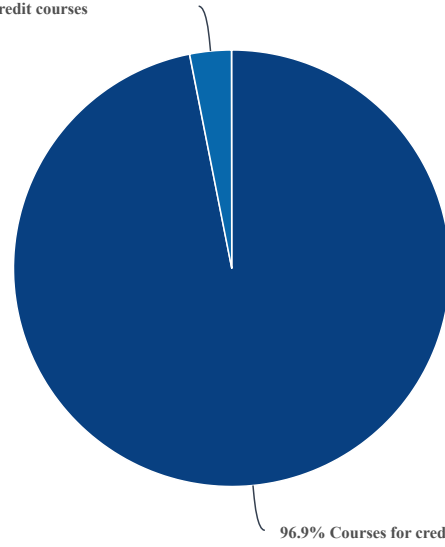
2. As of today, are you attending college full-time or part-time?

3. In the past year, what classes have you primarily been enrolled in at the college?

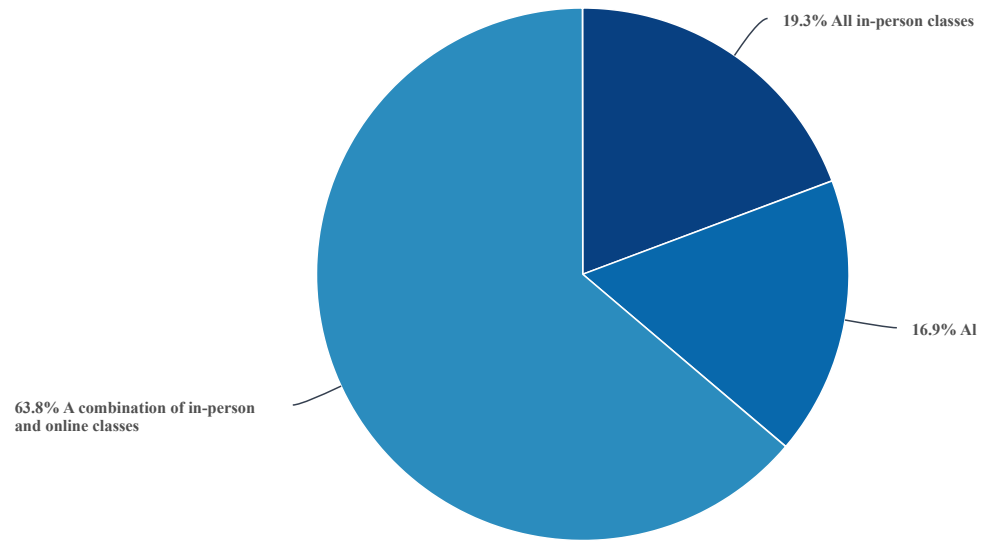

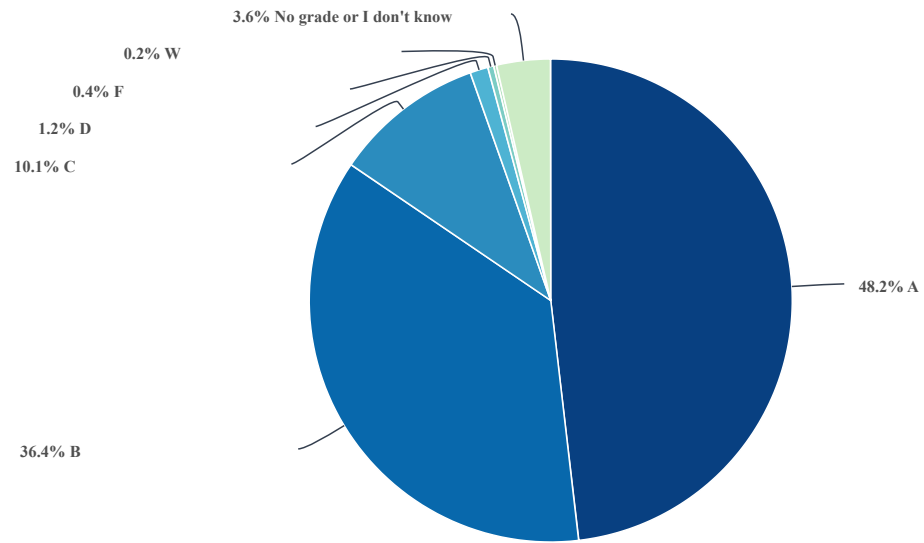

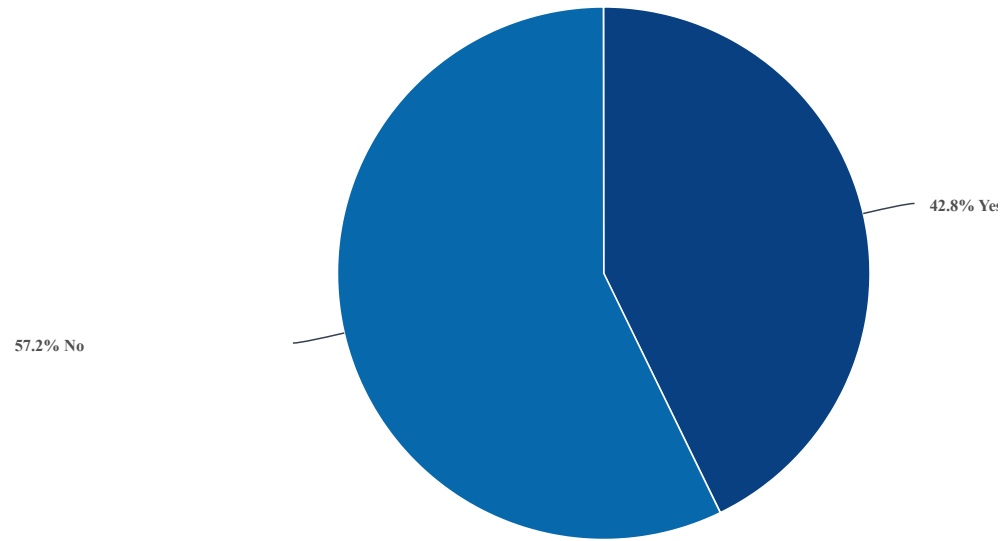


9. Thinking about all of your jobs, on average, about how much do you earn an hour?

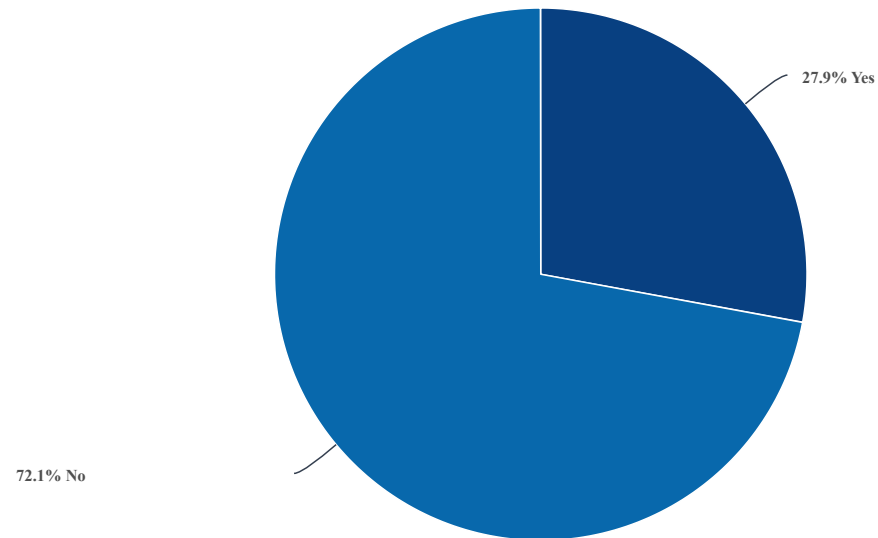

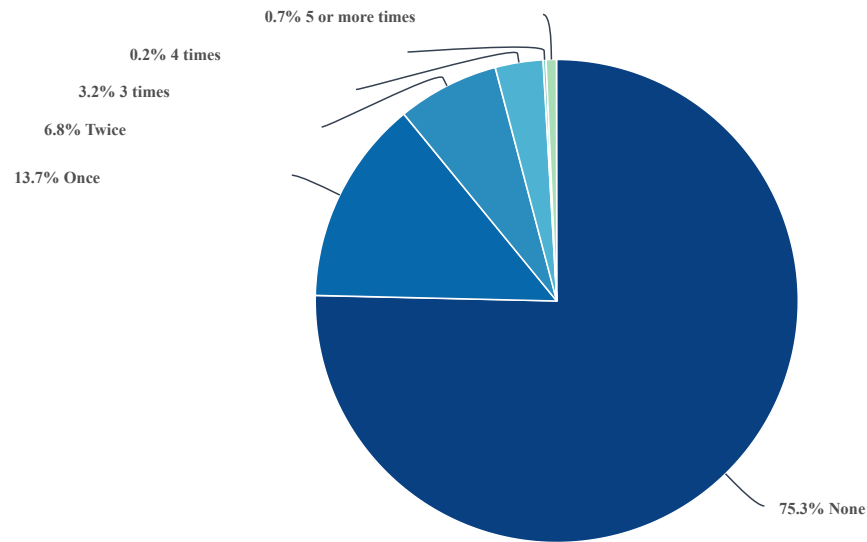

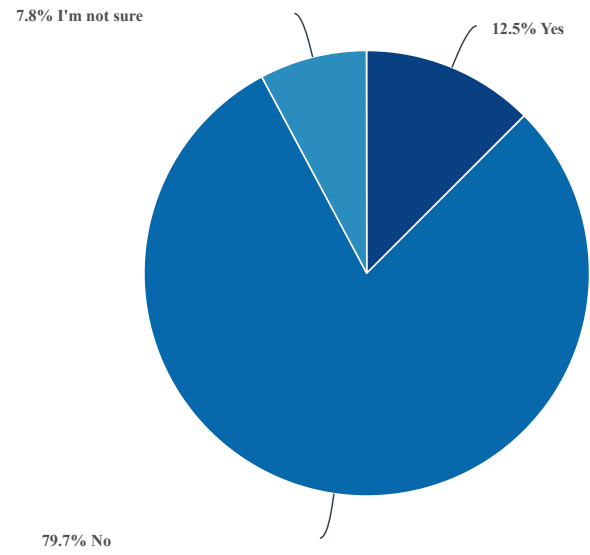

13. In the past 12 months, how many times have you moved?



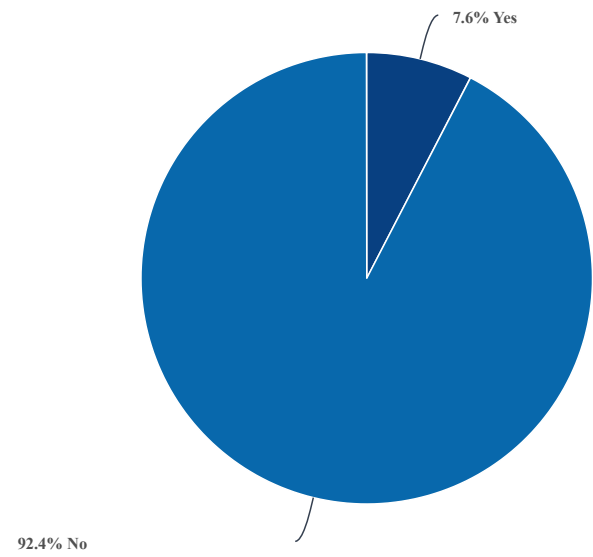

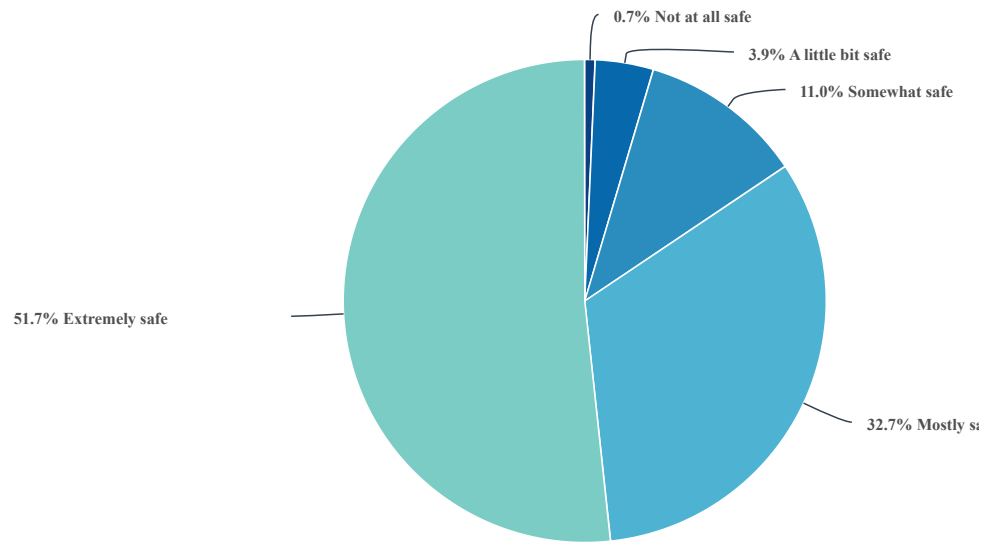

15. In the past 12 months, did you leave your household because you felt unsafe?



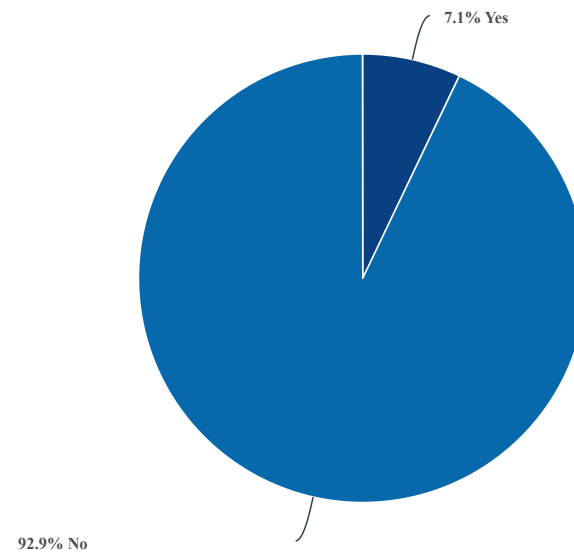

16. How safe do you feel where you currently live?



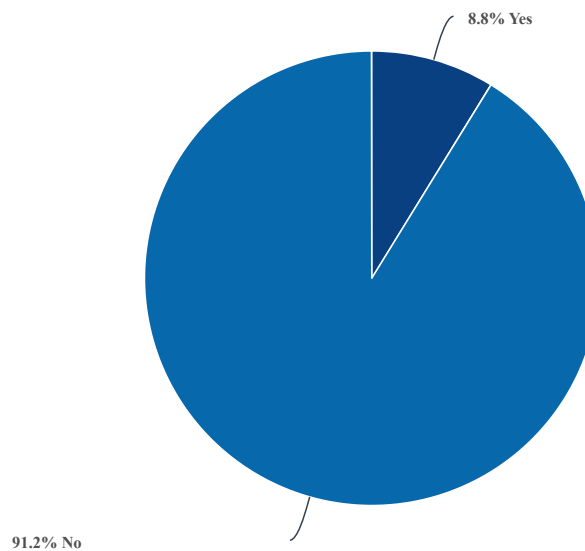

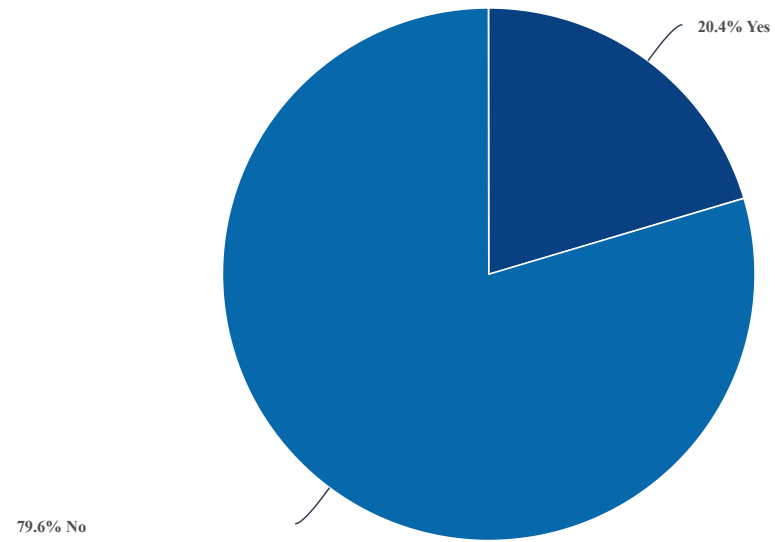

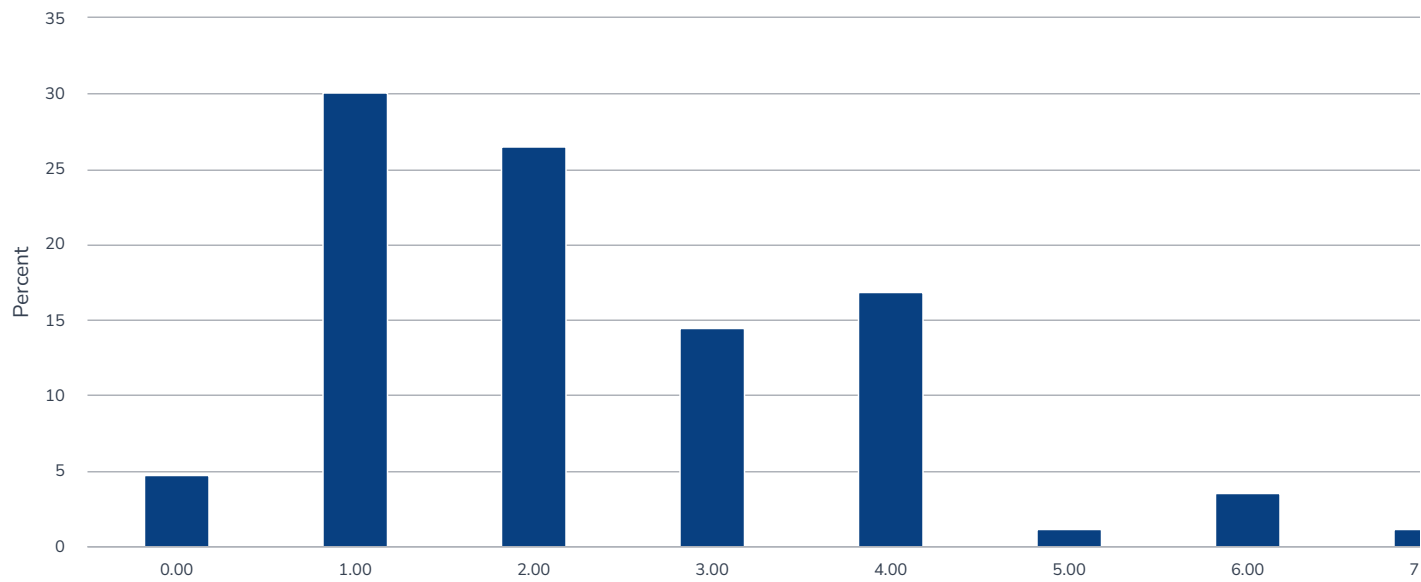

22. Do you have any biological, adopted, step, or foster children who live in your household?

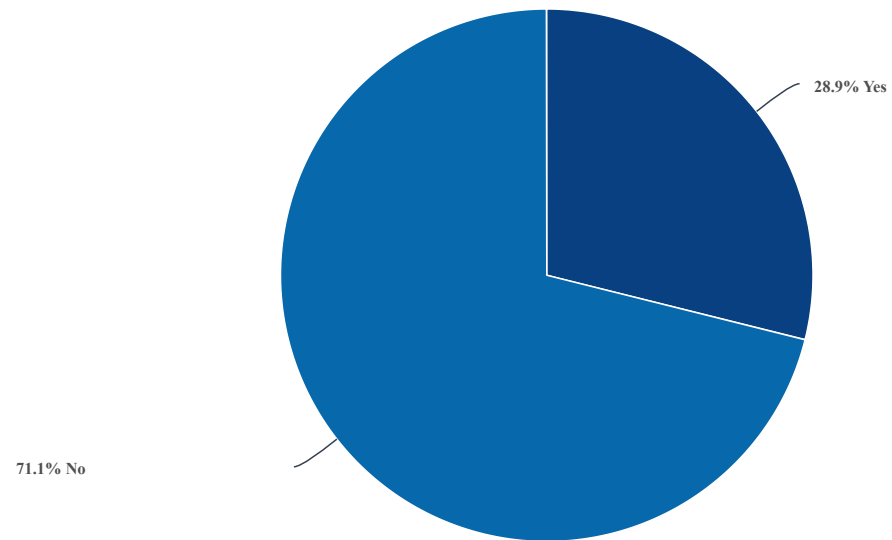

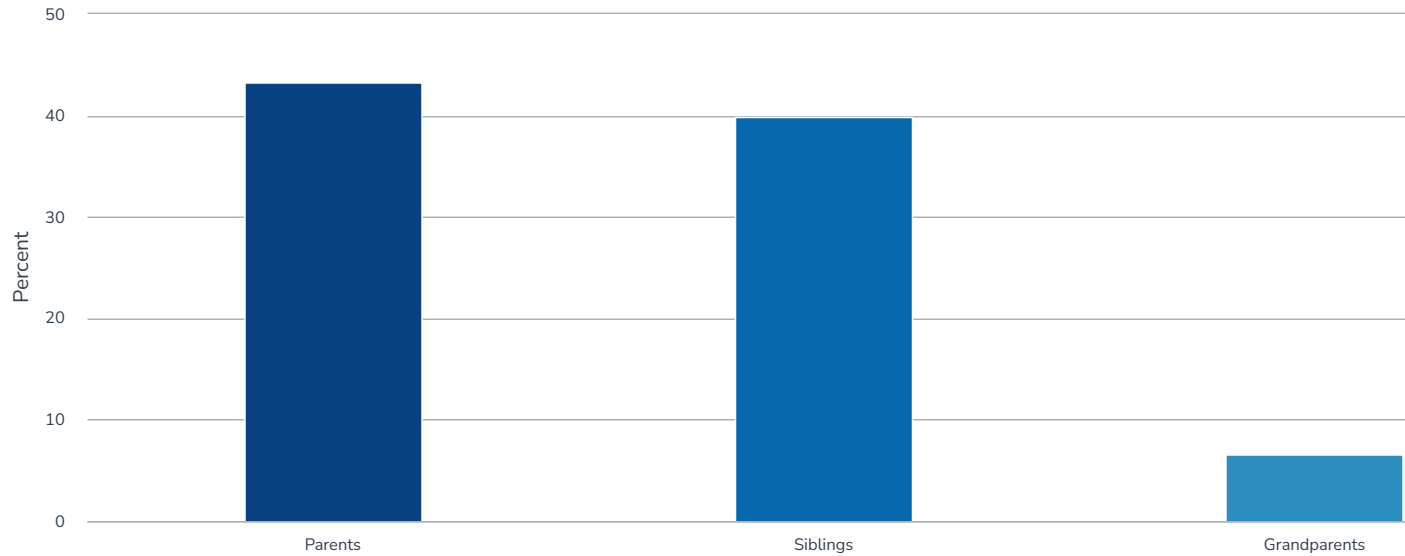
24. Do you consider yourself to be a single parent?

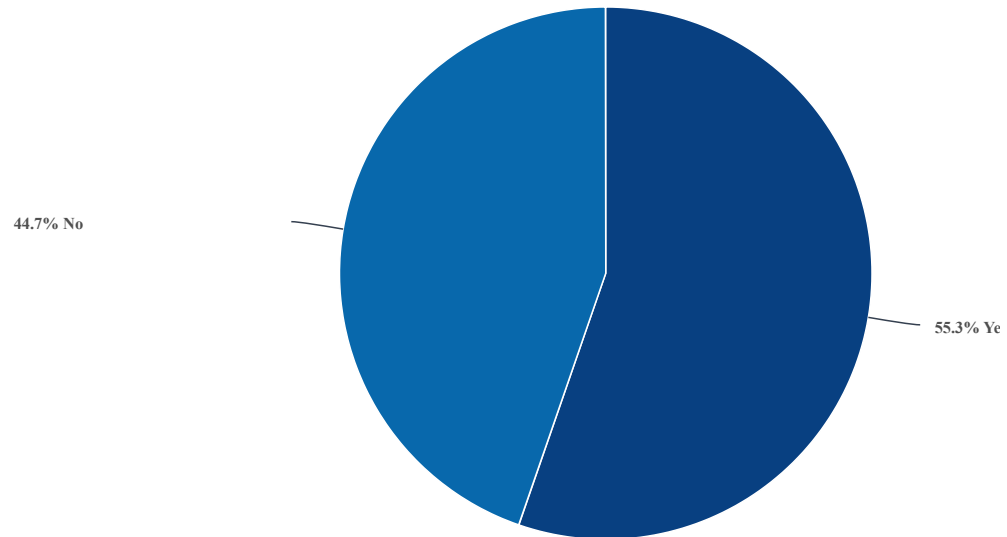

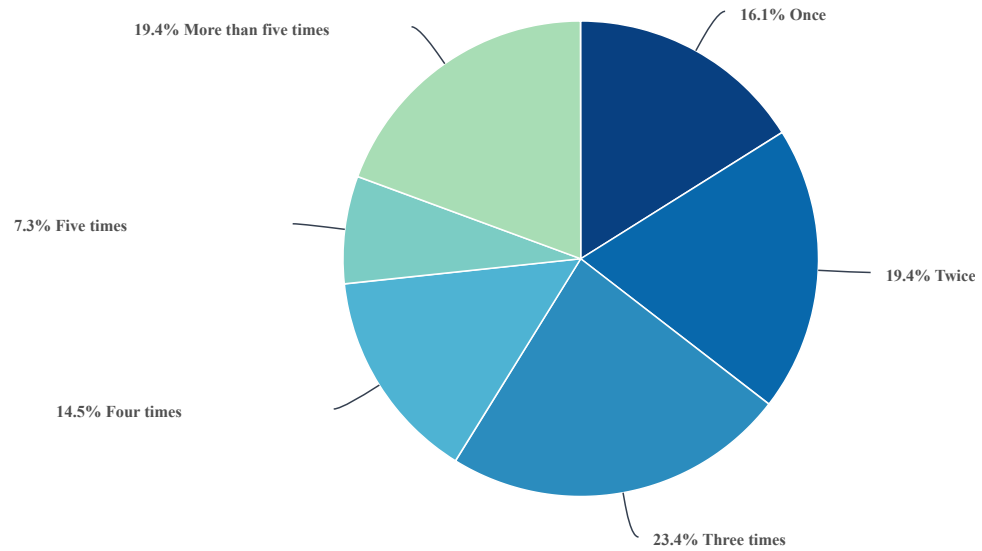

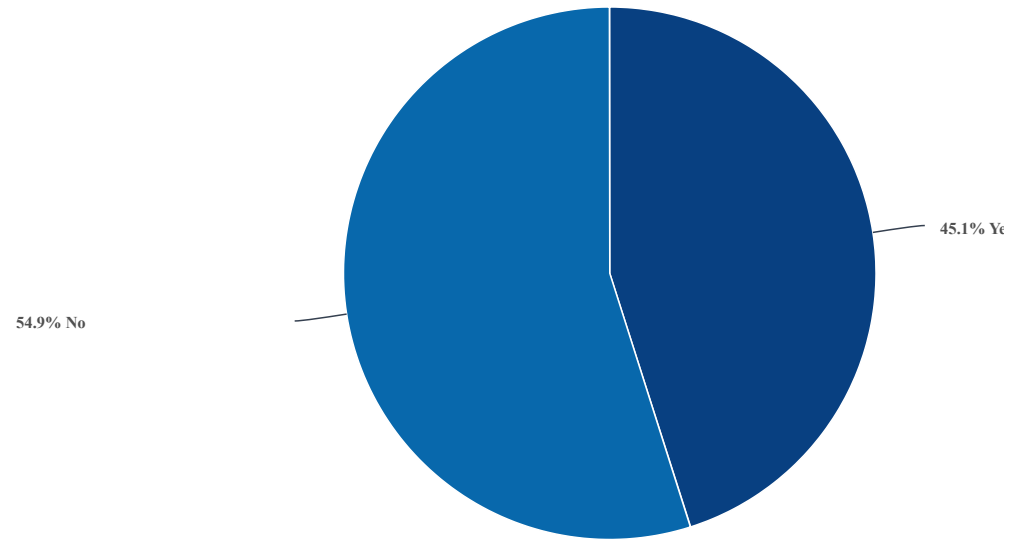

29. In the last 30 days, did you ever eat less than you felt you should because there wasn't enough money for food?



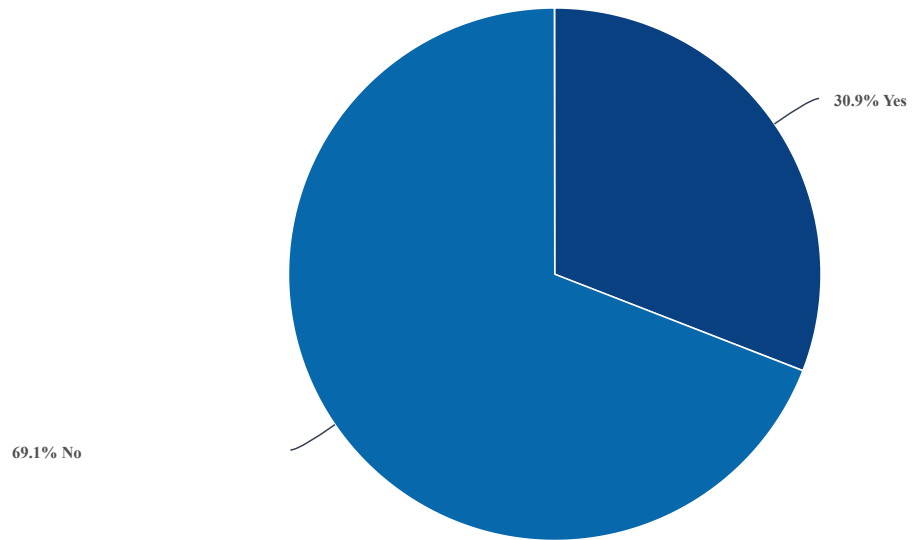

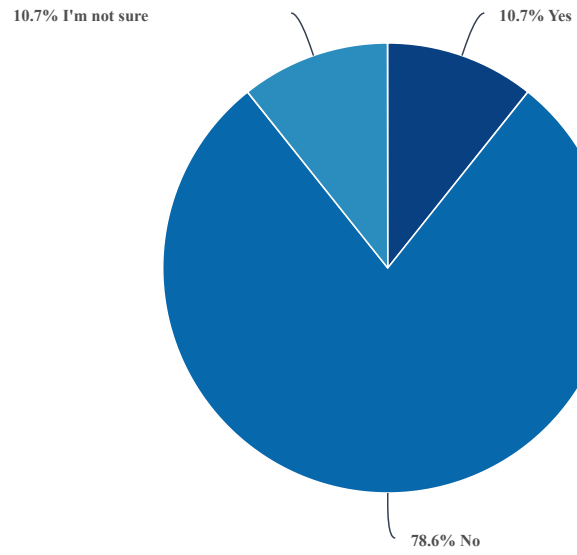

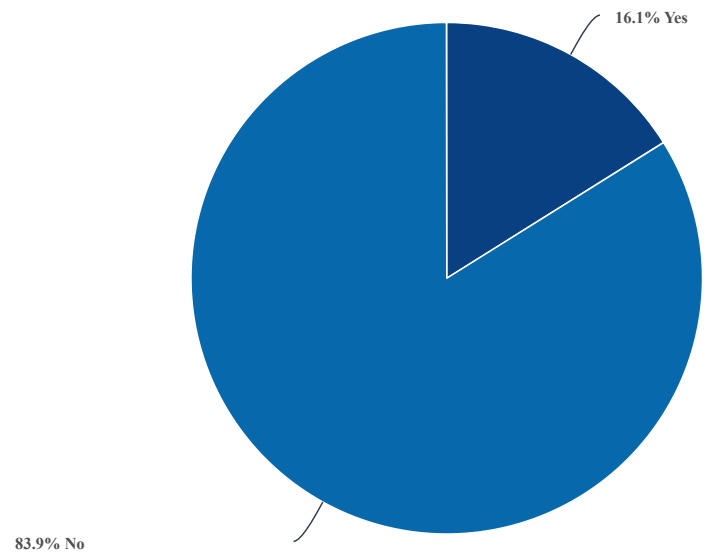

32. In the last 30 days, did you stay in an unhealthy relationship so you or you and your family would have enough food?



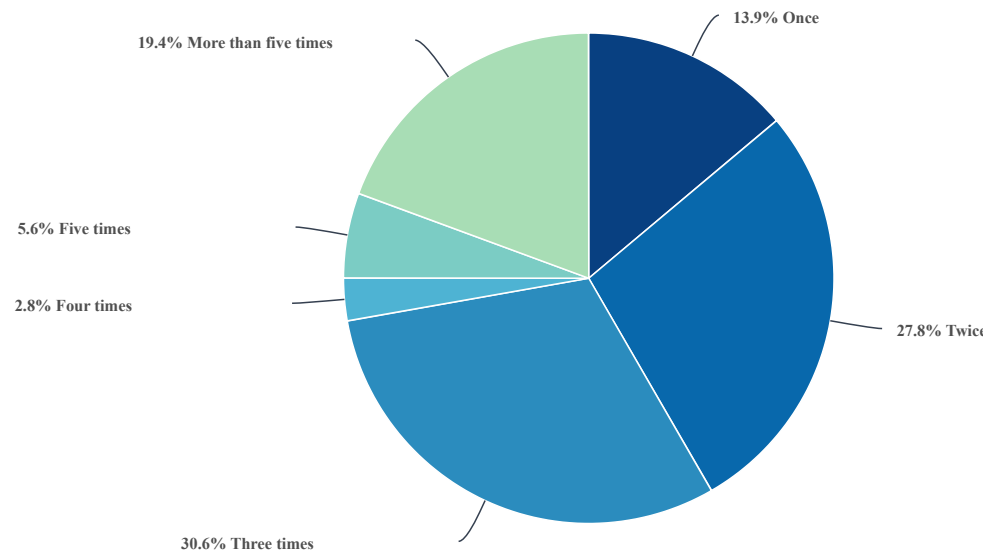

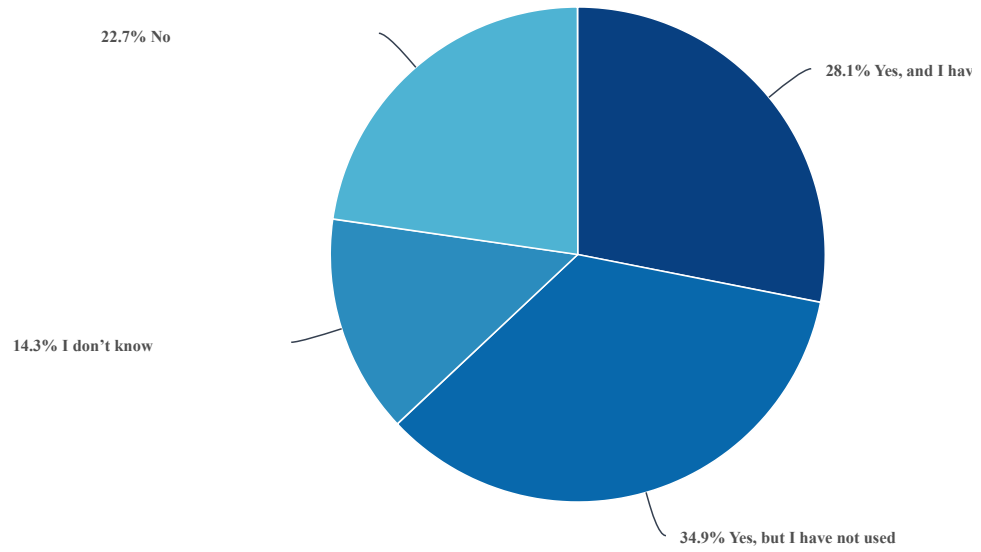

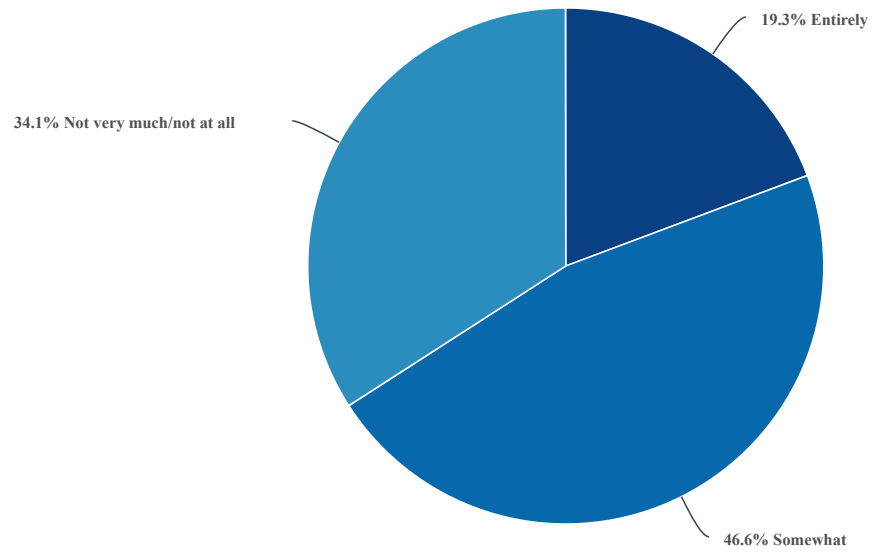

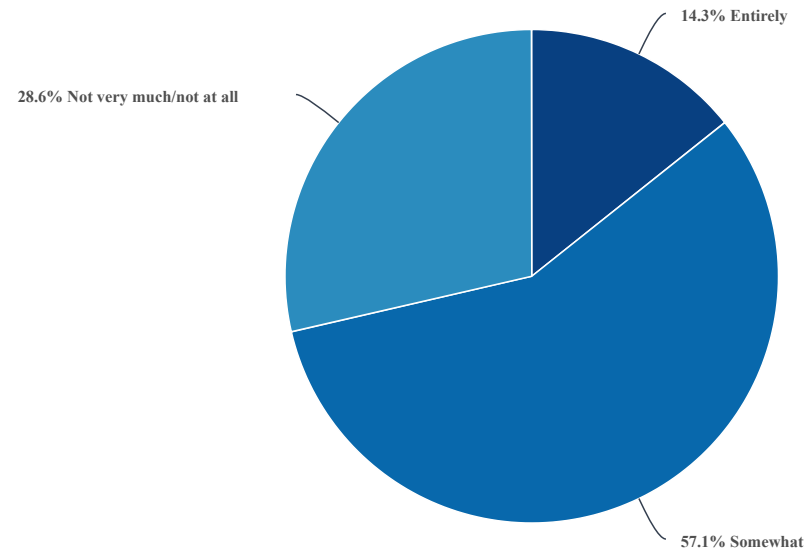

41. To what degree do you rely on the food supports provided by your college to support you?

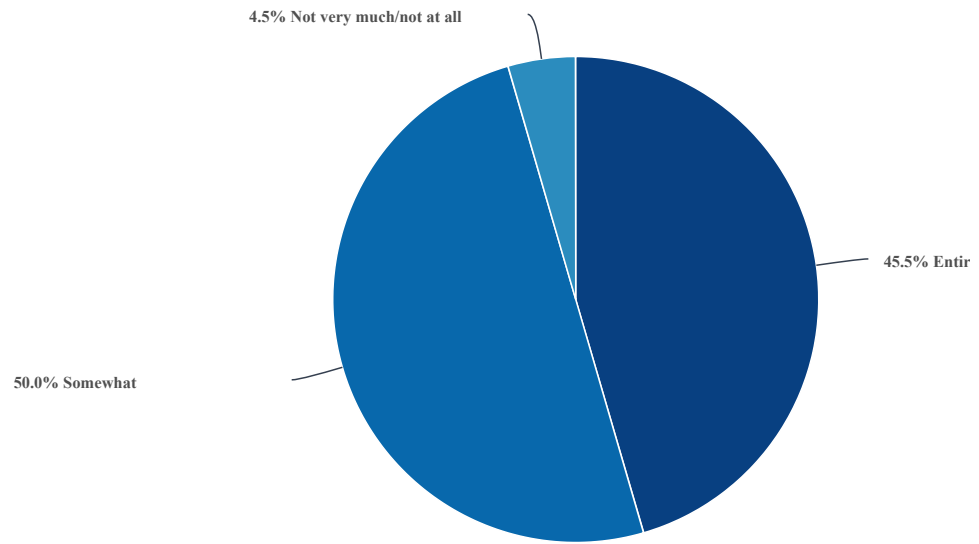

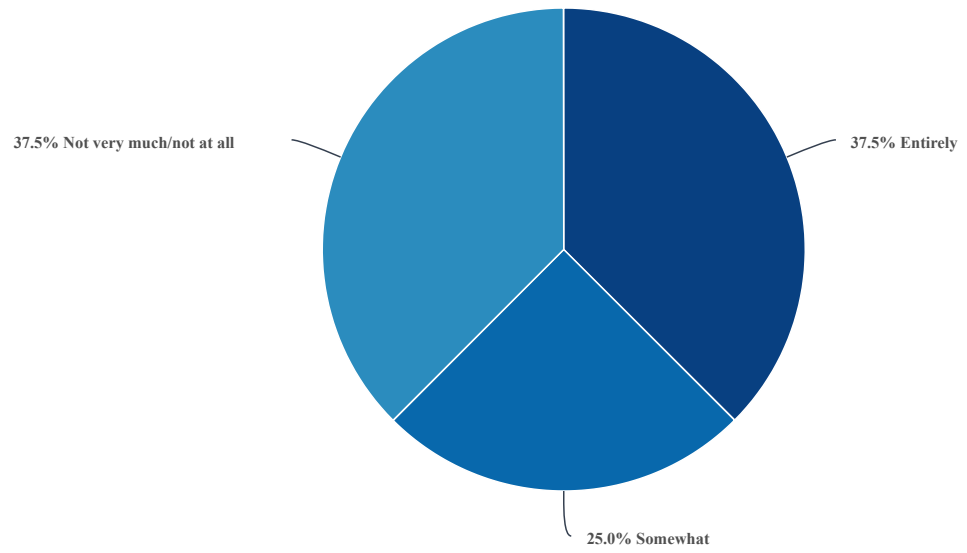
42. To what degree do you rely on the housing supports provided by your college to support you?



43. To what degree do you rely on the mental health supports provided by your college to support you?

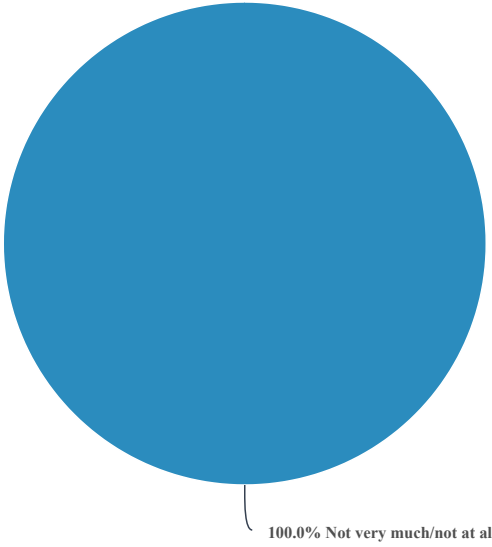


44. To what degree do you rely on the physical health supports provided by your college to support you?



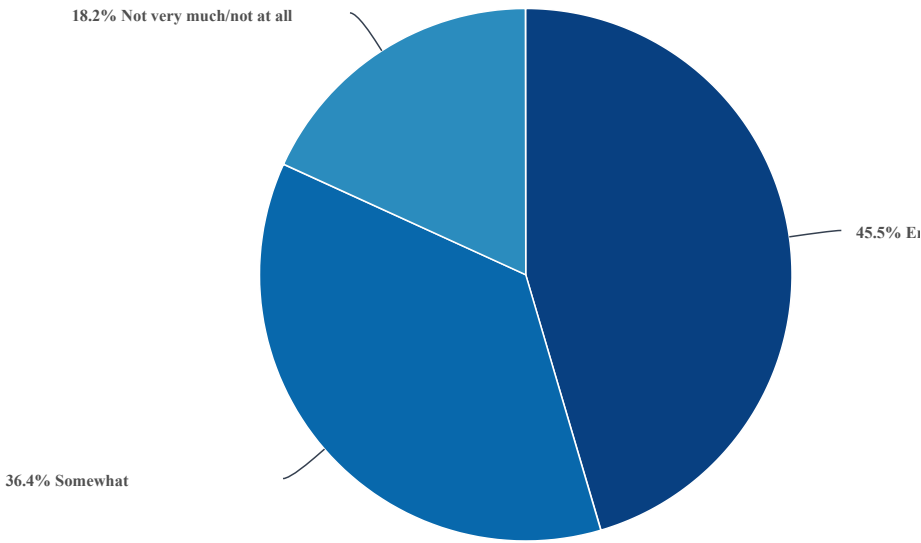

45. To what degree do you rely on the childcare supports provided by your college to support you?



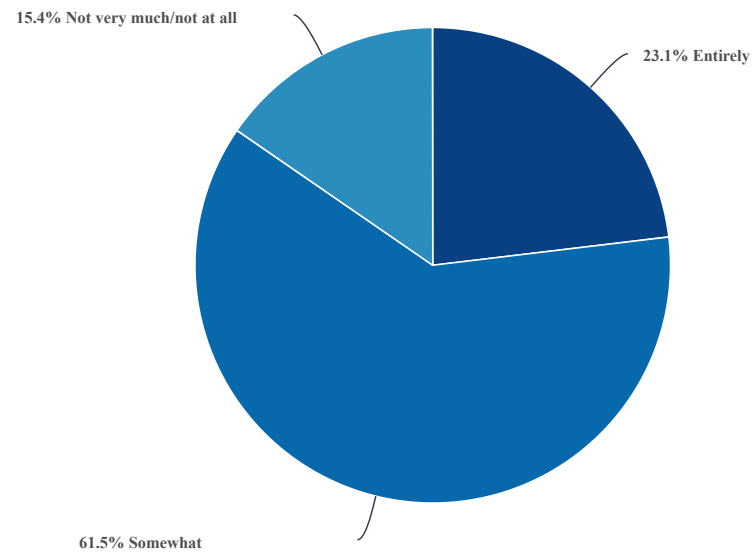

46. To what degree do you rely on the transportation supports provided by your college to support you?



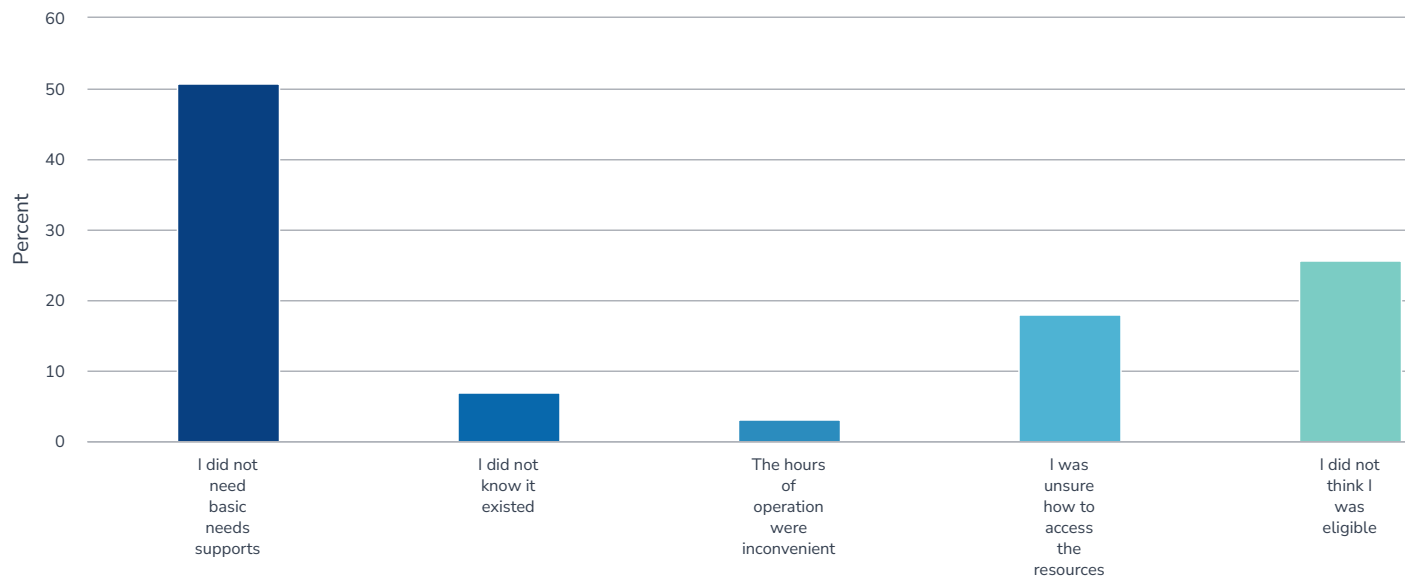

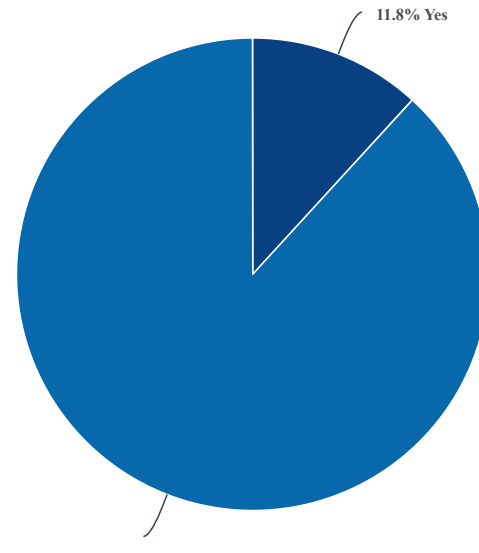

60. Have you ever served in the U.S. Armed Forces, Military Reserves, or National Guard?



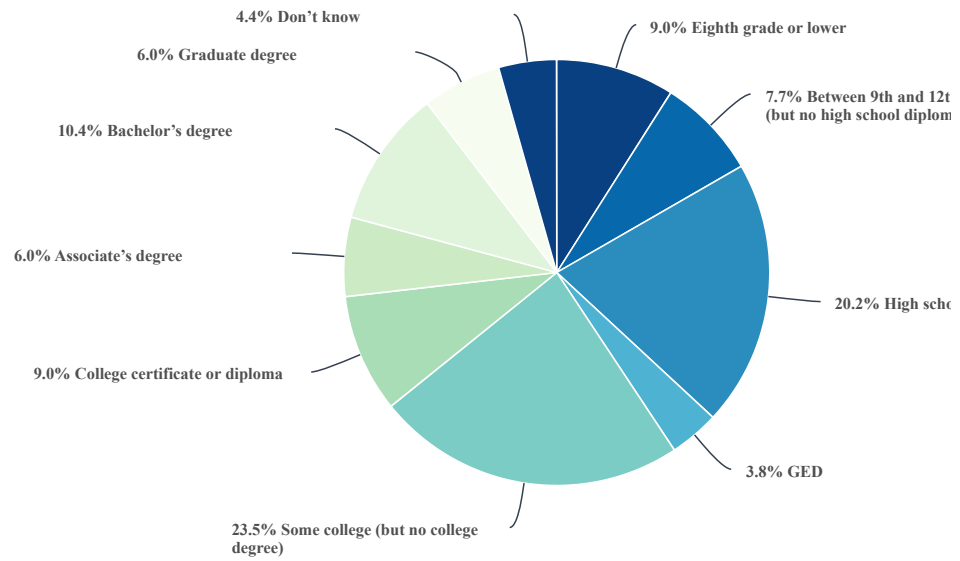
