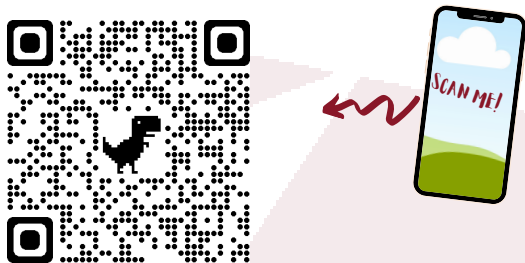


NORCO ADVANTAGE

Complete a 2022-2023 Financial Aid Application

- 3 ACTIVATE YOUR RCCD STUDENT EMAIL**
DON'T FORGET TO CHECK YOUR EMAIL! (ex. @student.rccd.edu)
 - Once your admissions application has been processed, a welcome letter will be sent to the personal email you provided in the application. Please allow at least 48 business hours.
 - Your student email will be the primary means by which college professors and departments communicate with you regarding registration dates, schedule changes, financial aid and more.

- 4 COMPLETE YOUR ONLINE STUDENT ORIENTATION**
First time college students are required to complete an online orientation in order to enroll in class.

Go to wa.RCCD.edu to access your WebAdvisor. In WebAdvisor, select "Take Your Online Orientation" under the Academic Planning tab to complete this step.

- 5 MEET WITH AN EDUCATIONAL ADVISOR**
First-time college students must meet with an Educational Advisor prior to registering.

To prevent any registration delays, schedule an appointment as soon as possible. Our Educational Advisors will help you get connected with special programs and resources.
