- 1 APPLY TO NORCO COLLEGE**
Go to www.norcocollege.edu and click **BECOME A STUDENT** followed by **Apply - Steps to Enroll** on the home page.

Applications generally take two days to process. Once an application has been processed, students will receive an email with an assigned Student ID number and RCCD student email address.

- 2 APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID**
Complete a Financial Aid Application
 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA): www.fafsa.gov
 - California Dream Act Application: www.dream.csac.ca.gov

- 3 ACTIVATE YOUR RCCD STUDENT EMAIL**
DON'T FORGET TO CHECK YOUR EMAIL! (ex. @student.rccd.edu)

- Once your admissions application has been processed, a welcome letter will be sent to the personal email you provided in the application. Please allow at least 48 business hours.
- Your student email will be the primary method the college professors and departments will communicate with you regarding registration dates, schedule changes, financial aid and more.

- 4 COMPLETE YOUR ONLINE STUDENT ORIENTATION**
First time college students are required to complete an online orientation in order to enroll in class.

Go to wa.RCCD.edu to access your WebAdvisor. In WebAdvisor, select "Take Your Online Orientation" under the Academic Planning tab to complete this step.

- 5 MEET WITH AN EDUCATIONAL ADVISOR**
First-time college students are encouraged to meet with an Educational Advisor prior to registering.

Our Educational Advisors will help you with course selection and connect you with special programs and resources.
