# Approved courses that will clear EAP Conditional Ready results

## **English**

Completion of a year-long English course taken your senior year in high school with a grade of C or better.

- Expository Reading and Writing Course (ERWC) Adopted as a full year course in the 12th grade being taught by a certified instructor.
- International Baccalaureate (IB) English
- Advanced Placement—Language and Composition or Literature and Composition
- English course approved for extra honors weight on the University of California "a-g" Doorways course 1

### Math

Completion of a year-long math course taken your senior year in high school with a grade of C or better.

- Trigonometry and Math Analysis
- Pre-Calculus
- Calculus
- AP Calculus AB
- AP Calculus BC
- AP Statistics
- AP Physics

Any other year-long high school math course with Algebra 2 or Integrated Math III as a prerequisite (except Statistics) is approved.
