
How do you access EduNav?

- Understand how any changes to your education plan affect your completion timeline.






From EduNav click on the Add a course button




Type in the section # of the course and click the select box




Next click on the CHANGE button and then the mark to register with an Add Code option




Under the CHANGE button, type in the add code given to you by your instructor and click on the Update Registration button.




Review your registration actions and then click on the "Continue Registration" button.

The course you added will appear on your plan and the word Registered will appear in green next to the course.




Reminders



- You must be fully vaccinated to be able to register for face to face or hybrid courses
- 1. If you have received either two required doses of the Moderna/Pfizer vaccines or one dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine and are eligible to receive a booster, then you need to get your booster by **March 15**, **2022**.
- 2. The weekly testing protocol is only applicable when you become eligible for the booster.
- 3. Once you become eligible to get the booster, you will be given 30 days to get the shot. Starting the second week of the Spring semester, you must go through regular weekly testing, which will be available at our three campuses. (The weekly testing requirement is being waived during the first week of Spring.)
