

## Promise Program Agreement 2022-2023

The Norco College Promise Program is designed to help first-time college students expedite the completion of their associate degree, transfer, and/or workforce certificate requirements. Students who commit to the program receive financial support to reduce college costs and increase their success. The Norco College Promise Program provides students with educational assistance and guidance to remain on track during their first year as college students.

## As a Promise Program participant, you will receive the following benefits:

- Enrollment fees not covered by financial aid for the 2022-2023 academic year.
  - ✓ Enrollment costs of \$46 per unit (12 units in Fall & Spring only)
  - ✓ Student services fee (\$30 in Fall & Spring only)
  - ✓ Health fee (\$20 in Fall & Spring only)
  - ✓ Transportation fee (\$8 in Fall & Spring only)
- Academic and career exploration workshops, university tours, and social activities.
- A comprehensive, semester-by-semester plan that maps out classes from the first semester to the last, based on an educational goal.
- Access to academic/career counseling and one-on-one peer support.

## following: (Read and initial each statement below) I must complete and file a 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), or the California Dream Act application, and list Norco as my home college. I must submit all documents requested by the Student Financial Services Office in a timely manner to complete my financial aid application. I must enroll full-time (12 units or more) in the Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 semesters. I will plan to enroll in English-1A during my first year (not recommended to take with Math). I will plan to enroll in my transferrable Math course during my first year. (Encouraged) I will maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress with a minimum 2.00-grade point average (GPA) during enrollment in the 2022-2023 academic year. I will seek academic support services such as tutorial services or supplemental instruction in order to maintain a 2.00 minimum GPA required. I will meet with a Norco College counselor in Fall 2022 to update my semester-by-semester educational plan prior to Winter and/or Spring enrollment. I will successfully complete the entire academic school year by making my education a priority, regularly attending all my classes, and setting realistic educational goals with my counselor and advisors. I will check my Norco College Student email weekly for updates, information, and communication from program personnel. I agree to notify Promise Program personnel of any changes in my status at Norco College, such as dropping a class, academic probation, withdrawal, leave of absence, transfer to another school, etc. \_\_ I will update any changes in my contact information (email, phone, mailing address) in WebAdvisor. I will follow the guidelines set forth by the Norco College Student Code of Conduct. By signing below, I agree to the terms of the Promise Program.
