

1098-T Questions and Answers

1. How do I get my 1098 -T form?
 - 1098-T forms for 2019 are available on WebAdvisor/MyPortal, go to the Students menu - under Other services, click on IRS Form 1098-T.
2. How do I get my 1098-T form for previous years, if I am no longer a student?
 - Students do not need to be enrolled to have access to WebAdvisor;
 - Student can reset their WebAdvisor password as long as they have access to their e-mail address on file.
 - If this does not resolve the issue, please e-mail Student Account Specialist [Carla Phillips](#) for further help, remember to include your student id in your correspondence.
3. Who receives a 1098-T form?
 - Students who were enrolled during calendar year 2019 and that made **enrollment fee** payments either for calendar 2019 or for a previous balance from calendar year 2018.
 - Students who were enrolled for an academic year that began or will begin in the first three months of 2020 and enrollment fees were paid in 2019.
4. I received Financial Aid; do I still get 1098-T form?
 - Yes, any grants or scholarships received during the tax year will be displayed in Box 5. Please note: **If you qualified for the CCPG (California College Promise Grant) for 2019 you will not receive a Form 1098-T.**
5. I was enrolled in the Apprenticeship Program; do I get a 1098-T form?
 - Yes, only for the enrollment fees paid out of pocket. If proof of enrollment is needed, students can print their class schedule in WebAdvisor.
6. I was enrolled in the Concurrent Enrollment Program/JFK and I paid health fees, and student services fees only. Will I received a 1098-T form?
 - High school students taking college courses do not pay enrollment fees; therefore a 1098-T form will not be issued.
7. I was part of the Promise Program; will I get a 1098-T form?
 - All enrollment and student fees for first-time college students are waived, therefore a 1098-T will not be issued.
8. I was part of the Dual Enrollment Program/CCAP; will I get a 1098-T form?
 - High School students taking college courses do not pay any fees, all enrollment fees and student fees are waived; therefore a 1098-T will not be issued.
9. I was enrolled during calendar year 2019 and a sponsor paid my enrollment fees, do I get a 1098-T form?
 - Yes, a 1098-T will be issued to the student.
