WHAT TO BRING

You'll need the following to complete the application:

- Your social security number and parent's social security number (if dependent)
- 2019 student's and parent's (if dependent) federal tax return (2020 taxes for 2022-2023 FAFSA or DREAM)
- 2019 untaxed income records (if any) (2020 taxes for 2022-2023 FAFSA or DREAM)
- o 2019 1099 form (if receiving unemployment) (2020 1099 form for 2022-2023 FAFSA or DREAM)
- 2019 W2 forms and other record of money earned (2020 W2 for 2022-2023 FAFSA or DREAM)

You are considered INDEPENDENT if:

- o You are 24 years of age or older
- o You are married
- You have a child that you support financially
- o You are a veteran
- o You are an orphan or have been a ward to the court

If you ARE NOT in any of these classifications, you are considered a DEPENDENT student AND need to add your parent/parents information to the FAFSA application.

All applications for financial assistance programs, (i.e., student loans, work compensation, grants, scholarship, special funds, subsidies, prizes, etc.), will be considered by the Riverside Community College District without regard to ethnic group identification, national origin, religion, age, sex or gender, race, color, ancestry, sexual orientation, physical or mental disability, or any characteristic listed or defined in Section 11135 of the Government Code or any characteristic that is contained in the prohibition of hate crimes set forth in subdivision (1) of Section 422.6 of the California Penal Code, or any other status protected by law.
