Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to July 1984 when the first seed was sown and the roots of Norco College were planted.

The Corona-Norco
Unified School District
was part of the Chaffey
College District.
Through a culmination
of efforts, an exchange
in territory took place
and CNUSD was
annexed into RCCD.
This marked a major
milestone in Norco
College's history.

The newly annexed CNUSD was 155 square miles and encompassed one-third of the total territory of RCCD. Within a year, over thirty- five percent of students came from the Corona-Norco areas.

The annexation papers were signed on July 1, 1984. The next day the Riverside Community College District held a "Celebration of Annexation" at the Norconian Club to welcome the cities of Corona and Norco. Both mayors were present and addressed the audience.


