Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to January 1997 when Norco College began offering classes on Friday nights, Saturdays and Sundays for its Weekend College.

Working adults were able to take classes on the weekends for the first time in Norco. It was part of an effort to make higher education more accessible for workers who wanted to change careers or get a promotion as well as those whose higher education pursuits were interrupted.

Course offerings included a heavy focus on business administration, computer science, and computer information classes according to Norco Provost Dr. Brenda Davis.

Enrollment was nearly 1,000 students within months of the program starting. Class sessions ranged from six weeks to eighteen weeks and many students took more than one class.
