Norco IMC invites you to take a look back to the view of Norco College from the air as it changed over the years.

The first aerial image dates back to 1975 when the land was owned by the U.S. Navy. Norco College was not even in the planning stages yet. To the north is Lake Norconian, and to the south, houses. Third Street would not be extended to reach the future campus until its construction in 1990.

The fully constructed phase I of the campus can be seen in the 1993 photograph. A few of the original Navy buildings are visible in the image as part of the college site.

Just a few short years later and Phase II completed, the 1996 photograph shows Norco College as it begins to grow. The college added a library, amphitheatre, parking lots, and an additional instructional building.

Over the years, Norco College has seen growth that is visibile in these aerial views.
