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## Program Comparison

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### How does your program compare to the college in the following areas: age, gender, ethnicity, FT/PT enrollment status?

Data compiled from 17FAL-20SPR

Age: 19 or young group is significantly lower by 26.32% and 25-29 group significantly higher by 14.9%. These two populations make sense as many veterans return to college after discharge.

Gender: Significantly higher male population by 24.33% and lower female population by 23.67% as compared to the general college population.

Ethnicity: In comparison to the Norco College average, Black or African American is significantly higher within the veterans population.

FT/PT: Veterans are enrolling as full-time students at 46.18% than the general student population.

### Program Comparison: Are there any gaps in demographic areas that need to be addressed?

Yes, there are fewer female veterans at Norco College and this needs to be addressed. While not a gap, I'm very delighted to see a higher Black of African American veterans at Norco College.

## Program Student Outcomes Comparison

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### How do student outcomes for your program compare to the college overall in Student Educational Planning, Success, GPA, and Persistence?

Student Ed Planning: Vets who developed an abbreviated and a comprehensive education plan are 17.97% higher than the general population. Vets who did not complete an education plan are 17.01% lower than the general student population.

Success: The veterans population is slightly lower by .5% in comparison to the general population.

GPA: The veterans population is slightly lower by .1

Persistence: The percent of 1st and 3rd term persistence is identical to the general population at 49.4%

### Program Student Outcomes: Are there any gaps in student subgroups that need to be addressed?

Yes, we need to provide additional counseling and tutoring services to the vets population to increase success, GPA, and persistence rates.
