
Norco Student Enrollment Spring 2020-Spring 2021

The following is an analysis of the distribution across colleges in the district for students taking at least one course at Norco College during Spring 2020. This group of students was followed over Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 (all enrollments as of the first day of the semester 2/16/2021) and the distribution over the three colleges is shown below for all three terms.



As indicated by the chart above, for students who were taking at least one course at Norco College in Spring 2020 (registration taking place pre-COVID), 82.5% of their enrollments were located at Norco College. Following this group into Fall 2020, 74.9% of their enrollments were at Norco College and in Spring 2021, 69.1% of their enrollments were at Norco College. Concurrently, during those terms, the proportion of enrollments rose at both Riverside City College (RCC) and Moreno Valley College (MVC). At RCC, enrollments rose from 12.8% to 23.5%, and at MVC enrollments rose from 4.7% to 7.4%.

There are many possible explanations for this shift in enrollment ranging from course availability to the various corollaries related to COVID impact. However, the primary conclusion is that Norco students' enrollments decreased at Norco College and increased at the other two colleges over the successive three semesters impacted by COVID and remote instruction. This may be one explanation to the decrease in overall enrollment and FTES that has been observed over the semesters involved in this analysis.
