Can I attend Norco College if I did not graduate from high school?

- Yes, if you are at least 18 years of age or older.

What is an AA/AS degree, and which ones are offered at Norco College?

- An AA/AS degree is an Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degree. See the college catalog for the current degree listing.

How do I get started at Norco College if I'm a new student?

Is Norco College on semesters or quarters?

- Norco College is on the semester system.

What is O.A.C.?

- O.A.C. stands for Orientation, Assessment, and Counseling. These are the three things that a New Student needs to complete before they can register for courses.

Do I have to complete my O.A.C. by a certain time?

- If you complete your O.A.C. by the date stated in the Order of Registration, you will receive the highest possible placement on the order of registration based on your student status. IMPORTANT: If you are a new student you may not register for courses unless your O.A.C. has been completed.

How do I find out my registration date and time?

- Access WebAdvisor to find out your registration date and time. You may register any time on or after your date and time.

Where do I purchase the college catalog? Where can I get a schedule of classes?

- The college catalog and schedule of classes are available free and may be viewed online.
